# MARY HAD MANY ANIMALS INSTEAD OF A LITTLE LAMB

Mary J Wilson was born in Baltimore, Maryland on January 2nd. She graduated with a **high school diploma** and realized she had a huge love of animals. She started out working at what was then called The Baltimore Zoo, now the Maryland Zoo, in 1961. Before working she did not have much **experience** but Arthur R. Watson, who was in charge of the zoo, saw that she loved animals and thought she would work hard! He was right!


Wilson was the first Black senior **zookeeper** in Baltimore.

Most women who were working at the zoo at that time either worked with birds or baby animals but Wilson worked with **mammals** like gorillas and elephants. One of the people she worked with said that elephants were her favorite. Other people who saw her work with the animals described her as **fearless**.

She loved her work so much that sometimes she even brought work home with her. She would care for the baby animals at her home - like monkeys, gorillas, and snakes. There are many stories about her even calming animals of all sizes and getting them back in their cages - even really **dangerous** animals like leopards.

She worked at the zoo for 38 years and retired in 1999.

She had an amazing **legacy**. Years later, her daughter was the first Black zookeeper at Omaha city zoo. Mary J Wilson died of **Coronavirus** in 2020 but the memories, her passion, and the impact of her work live on.



# HABITATS



## GLOSSARY

**High school diploma** - document which shows that a person has finished a course of study or has graduated from a high school

**Zookeeper** - a person who takes care of the animals in a zoo

**Mammals** - a type of animal that feeds milk to its young and that usually has hair or fur covering most of its skin

**Fearless** - not afraid : very brave

**Dangerous** - able or likely to cause injury, pain, harm, etc.

**Coronavirus** - an illness caused by the coronavirus, is like the flu and can cause a person's body to feel sick

**Legacy** - something that happened in the past or that comes from someone in the past
