

SPIKE LEE: STORYTELLING THROUGH FILM

Instructions: Read the following text about Spike Lee's life. Like in a movie, details are important. Use the key details in this text to determine the author's point.

Lights. Camera. Action. Those are the words that we think about when we think about film. And Spike Lee is a name we often hear when we talk about Black films.

His dad was a musician and his mother was a school teacher so it's no **surprise** that Spike Lee, whose real name is Shelton Lee, is **creative**. Spike Lee was born in Atlanta, Georgia but at a young age he moved to Brooklyn, New York. Later he moved back to Atlanta to go to a College called Morehouse. At Morehouse, he was also able to take classes at Clark Atlanta University, where he started to learn about film.

In 1980 he made his first film and in 1986 he made a film called *She's Gotta Have It* which helped his career to **explode**. That movie helped him to start his own production company. His next movie, which was called *School Daze*, was inspired by his college **experience** and was also very **popular**.



Spike Lee has created many films, and even though they are about different things most of them are about African-American experiences. His movies helped people to have conversations about what was going on in the lives of Black people and some of the **issues** that they faced.





Lee has also made different types of films, documentaries, and even music videos. Because of his amazing work he has been **nominated** for five Academy Awards, winning one of them, plus two special Oscars, which are all very well-known film awards. He's also won many other awards for his work as well.


